Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. When can I begin set up?** Set up hours begin at park & building on Thursday Noon – 6PM. Sales may be conducted Friday & Saturday 9 AM – 6 PM & Sunday 9 AM – 3 PM. Security will be provided throughout the night at the park.
- 2. Where can I park my vehicle?** Non-food vendors may enter the park for unloading & loading merchandise at both the north & south end of park. Vehicles must **be removed immediately** from park grounds after unloading/loading. All day parking is available at the Sports Complex located east of Hwy 395; directly across from the park. **No overnight parking** is allowed.
- 3. May I bring my pet?** Yes, however, dogs must be well behaved, confined to your vendor space & **leashed** at all times. A pet park is located north of the tennis courts. You must clean up after your pet & remove all food from space each night.
- 4. What are the park rules?** No silly string, canned hair color, pop streamers, fireworks or firearms are allowed in the park during the event. No bikes or scooters during event hours. **No exceptions.** You will be subject to removal if not in compliance.
- 5. Is ice available?** The closest location for ice purchase is Mobil Mini Mart & Lone Pine Market.
- 6. How do I find the local motels/hotels?** A list of lodging is attached & can also be viewed at www.lonepinefilmfestival.org.
- 7. Why can't I have the same space every year?** Spaces are on a first-come-first-serve basis. Reservations should be made early. We will make every effort to accommodate returning vendor space requests; however, there may be variations.
- 8. What does the vendor fee cover?** The vendor fee is for the 10' x 10' space only. It does not include any film festival events, etc.
- 9. How can I purchase items or tickets in advance?** Purchases can be made at the Museum or online at www.lonepinefilmfestival.org prior the film festival & picked up at the ticket office on Thursday.
- 10. How can I ensure I will be contacted for next year's film festival?** Your application has been entered into our data base which will be used for future contact. Please ensure your information is current & includes your email address.
